SUBJECT: Memorandum of Understanding for Cooperative Planning and Development of the
Santa Ana River Trail – District I & II

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board:

1. Approves Memorandum of Understanding for Cooperative Planning and Development of the Santa Ana River Trail with the Cities of Corona and Norco;
2. Authorizes the Chairperson to execute eight (8) copies of the Agreement; and
3. Directs the Clerk of the Board to return seven (7) copies of the Agreement to the Regional Park and Open-Space District (Parks District) for transmittal and file.

BACKGROUND: The Parks District is conducting trail expansions across Riverside County due to an increase in service demand resulting from population growth. The Santa Ana River Trail, reaching from the San Bernardino Mountains to the coast, is being upgraded in segments in a joint effort with a number of public and private agencies including the counties of Riverside, San Bernardino, and Orange, the cities of Riverside and Corona, and others.

SUBJECT: Memorandum of Understanding for Cooperative Planning and Development of the Santa Ana River Trail

On July 1, 2008, your honorable Board authorized the acceptance of the grant funds from the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 84) for the development of segments from the San Bernardino Mountains through the counties of Riverside, Orange, and San Bernardino.

The Proposition 84 grant award has been divided over a five-year period. Through a joint venture with the Cities of Corona and Norco, the Memorandum of Understanding for Cooperative Planning and Development of the Santa Ana River Trail (MOU) the following pre-construction work will be completed: prepare an alignment plan, engineering studies and environmental review for projects to complete twenty-two and one-half miles of varying segments along the Santa Ana River Trail from the Orange County line up to the Hidden Valley Wildlife Area. The City of Corona will be acting as the project lead with members from the Parks District and the City of Norco participating of the Project Team to ensure that all parties involved are able to play a role in the development of the trails through the joint jurisdictions.

The MOU was approved by the Corona and Norco Cities Councils on August 20, 2008.

The office of County Counsel has reviewed and approved the MOU as legal to form.
