BACKGROUND:

Since 1996, CAP Riverside's Alternative Dispute Resolution Center has trained volunteers to provide mediation services to the Superior Court and the community. In 2006, CAP Riverside developed a school-based peer mediation training module and currently provides training at four middle schools. School-based peer mediation trains students in conflict resolution and cultural diversity training to help reduce gang activity and violence on school campuses.

In the attached agreement with MVUSD, CAP Riverside will provide four-week Peer Mediation workshops at Sunnymead and Landmark Middle Schools.

The Executive Director of CAP Riverside requests that the Board approve the Agreement between MVUSD and CAP Riverside covering the term July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: No County General Funds will be required.
