SUBJECT: County Service Area 115 Advisory Board

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve Resolution No. 2008-396 dissolving the County Service Area 115 Advisory Board.

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to Board Policy A-48, an Advisory Board was created for County Service Area (CSA) 115 to provide recommendations on policy matters within the CSA. CSA 115 provides street lighting and road service however the Advisory Board was previously the only meeting forum for residents of the Desert Hot Springs community. As a result, the CSA 115 Advisory Board is often asked by residents to intervene on a variety of public issues, such as planning, code enforcement complaints, graffiti, law enforcement, etc. Recently, the Board created the Desert Hot Springs Municipal Advisory Council (MAC) to provide input to the Board of Supervisors on matters of concern to the residents. This MAC will advise on the full range of issues within the community, including the street light and road issues covered by the CSA. Therefore, in order to avoid duplication of services and more effectively meet the needs of the community, it is recommended that the Board dissolve the CSA 115 Advisory Board and assign responsibility for advising on street light and road issues to the Desert Hot Springs MAC.

5 **DISSOLUTION OF COUNTY SERVICE AREA 115 ADVISORY BOARD**

6 **WHEREAS**, on August 16, 1983, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 83-
7 262 Establishing an Advisory Committee for County Service Area No. 115; and

8 **WHEREAS**, on November 7, 2006, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No.
9 2005-148, Adopting Uniform Rules and Procedures for Advisory Committees, Boards and
10 Commissions of the County of Riverside which states that the Board of Supervisors may, at any
11 time and in its sole discretion, dissolve the advisory group by resolution; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 31010 and Riverside County Board Policy No.
13 A-51 provides for the creation of a Municipal Advisory Council within unincorporated territory
14 for the purpose of advising the Board of Supervisors on matters including, but not limited to,
15 public safety, planning, health, transportation, parks and community development; and

16 **WHEREAS**, on August 28, 2007, the Board of Supervisors approved Resolution 2007-420
17 Creating the Desert Hot Springs Municipal Advisory Council; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the Desert Hot Springs Municipal Advisory Council will be tasked with the
19 additional duties to advise on street lighting and road issues.

20 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED** by the
21 Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session
22 assembled on September 16, 2008, that the County Service Area 115 Advisory Board be
23 dissolved and all incumbent advisory board members be removed.
