**SUBJECT: HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT AGREEMENT—
RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH**

BACKGROUND:

On May 22, 2007 (Agenda Item 3.32), the Board authorized DPSS to submit an application for Homeless Assistance funds to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, which included the Desert Outreach Supportive Housing Program, operated through a Memorandum of Understanding between the Department of Mental Health (DMH) and DPSS to provide outreach to homeless individuals in Mid-County and Desert Regions who are mentally ill. The Department of Mental Health's outreach project goal is to serve 400 homeless individuals each year.

During FY 07/08, DMH met and exceeded its goal to serve 400 homeless persons by over 450%. The Desert Outreach Team engaged 1,869 single, homeless adults, 19 of which were veterans.

While the original project ended on January 31, 2008, there was a delay with the HUD national office processing the attached renewal Grant Agreement, which created a delay in the local Los Angeles HUD field office renewing the Desert Outreach project. As a consequence, this Agreement is being presented to the Board for approval retroactively to February 1, 2008.
