This program has increased literacy in middle schools throughout the city and these funds provide awards for the most prolific readers. The Moreno Valley Black Chamber of Commerce hosts an annual awards banquet and these funds provide sponsorship for the event. Palm Springs Police Activities League provides alternative activities for at-risk youth. These funds assist in providing activities for more young people. The Nuvview Youth Sports Organization is holding a fundraiser to purchase additional equipment and these funds assist them in reaching their goals.
