BACKGROUND: (Continued)

There are no changes to the current rates and these rates are guaranteed for the next two years. MES is a fully insured vision plan offered to County employees represented by SEIU, LIUNA, and RSA Public Safety. We currently have 8,032 active employees enrolled and approx. 465 retirees to be enrolled with MES effective January 1, 2009. MES continues to provide quality vision benefits and provides a broad network of providers for member convenience.
