**SUBJECT: HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT AGREEMENT—
RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH**

BACKGROUND:

On May 22, 2007 (Agenda Item 3.32), the Board authorized DPSS to submit an application for Homeless Assistance funds to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, which included the Women's Permanent Housing Program. The program is operated through a Memorandum of Understanding between the Department of Mental Health and DPSS, and is located at multiple sites within Riverside County.

The Women's Permanent Housing Program provides permanent housing for single women, without children, who have serious mental health disorders. This agreement provides funding for real property leasing, supportive services and operations. The program's goal is to serve six (6) women, who are chronically homeless and severely mentally ill. The anticipated outcomes for this project are to maintain an average of six (6) women in permanent housing; assist 100% of participants in increasing their skills and income and link 100% of participants to ongoing supportive services, mental health treatment and case management.

According to the latest Annual Progress Report submitted by the Department of Mental Health, for the time period 12/01/06 through 11/30/07, four (4) individuals entered the program and four (4) individuals exited the program. Of the four (4) individuals who have completed the program, 80% have maintained housing for more than six (6) months, and three (3) individuals have secured employment.

There are no changes to the persons to be served, the service site(s), or service modalities between this Agreement and the expiring Agreement.

The current agreement expires on Nov. 30, 2008.
