**SUBJECT: HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT AGREEMENT—
LUTHERAN SOCIAL SERVICES**

BACKGROUND:

On May 22, 2007 (Agenda Item 3.32), the Board authorized DPSS to submit an application for Homeless Assistance funds under the Supportive Housing Program to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development that included the Amelia's Light renewal project sponsored by Lutheran Social Services of Riverside.

Amelia's Light Transitional Living Program is a 22 unit, 88 bed program in which residents (22 adults and 66 children) may stay up to 24 months. One hundred percent of residents in this program are homeless. Four percent of residents may be chronic substance abusers and 35% may be victims of domestic violence. This Agreement provides funding for supportive services, operations, administrative costs, and participation in the Homeless Management Information System. Lutheran Social Services has a cash match obligation of approximately \$59,160. It is anticipated that at least 63.5% of those housed will move on to permanent housing and that at least 19% will exit with employment.

According to the latest Annual Progress Report submitted by Lutheran Social Services for the time period 11/01/2006 through 10/31/2007, 22 adults and 54 children entered the program and 23 adults and 57 children exited the program. Of those adults exiting the program, 74% moved into permanent housing and 52% gained income from employment.

There are no changes to the persons to be served, the service site(s), or service modalities between this Agreement and the expiring Agreement which ends on October 31, 2008.
