RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve and:

1. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached Grant Agreement between DPSS and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the attached ABC Recovery Center Transitional Living Village Supportive Housing Program Grant for \$42,192 from December 1, 2008 through November 30, 2009;
2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached contract HU 3083-00, between DPSS and ABC Recovery Center;
3. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to sign ministerial amendments with ABC Recovery Center, not to exceed the maximum amount of the Grant Agreement (\$42,192); and
4. Authorize the Director of DPSS to administer the agreement with ABC Recovery Center.

**SUBJECT: HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT
AGREEMENT—ABC Recovery Center**

BACKGROUND:

On May 22, 2007 (Agenda Item 3.32), the Board authorized DPSS to submit an application for Homeless Assistance funds under the Supportive Housing Program to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, which included the Transitional Living Village Program renewal project sponsored by ABC Recovery Center of Indio.

ABC's Transitional Living Village is a ten unit, forty bed program in which residents may stay up to 24 months. One hundred percent of residents in this program are homeless and chronic substance abusers. Approximately 25% are chronically homeless. This Agreement provides funding for supportive services, operations, and administrative costs. ABC has a cash match obligation of approximately \$12,000. It is anticipated that at least 63.5% of those housed will move on to permanent housing and that at least 19% will exit with employment.

According to the latest Annual Progress Report submitted from ABC for the time period 12/01/2006 through 11/30/2007, 73 people entered the program and 77 exited the program. Of those exiting, 70% moved into permanent housing and 86% gained income from employment.

There are no changes to the persons to be served, the service site(s), or service modalities between this Agreement and the expiring Agreement.

Although the current Grant does not expire until November 30, 2008, HUD has forwarded the renewal Grant to DPSS, which we are forwarding to your Board for approval.
