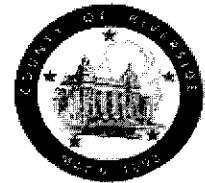

On September 24, 2008, the City of Wildomar signed an Agreement with the County for the provision of law enforcement services by the Sheriff's Department during the City's Post-Incorporation transition period and continuing until June 30, 2011. During this period, the Sheriff's Department will continue to provide the same level of service to the City area as it did previous to the incorporation. More specifically, that level consists of 77 daily Patrol hours (15.8 Deputies) with associated sworn supervision and classified support for the City.

Further, since the California Highway Patrol will no longer provide traffic enforcement to Wildomar, the City and the Sheriff have agreed to augment this level of service with an additional two Deputies who will be deployed for traffic enforcement duties.

Sheriff's staff has estimated the cost for this service at \$4,021,949 in FY 2008-09. All costs for this service will be recovered at Board approved rates. County Counsel has approved this Agreement as to form.
