**BACKGROUND:** Transitional Case Management Program (TCMP) was created by the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation to provide case management services to inmates and parolees who have been diagnosed with Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) or Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS).

**SUBJECT:** Ratify the Agreement between State of California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation and the County of Riverside Community Health Agency, Department of Public Health (Contract P08.0040).

**BACKGROUND: (Continued)**

TCMP services are initiated while the offender is in custody and continue following release to parole supervision. TCMP provides on-going support, counseling; education and case management to ensure that HIV infected parolees secure a stable living environment and remain in medical care.

Another goal of the TCMP program is to educate clients on how not to transmit the virus, reducing transmission to non infected individuals. The department of Public Health HIV Program has been providing TCMP services since 1998.

**FINANCIAL DATA:** The Agreement is 100% funded by State of California Department of Corrections. This grant does not require any County funds.
