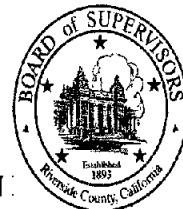



BACKGROUND:

The California Wildland Firefighter Memorial is a tribute to firefighters that have paid the ultimate sacrifice fighting wildland fires in the State of California. This memorial is located on its own dedicated highway; the Ortega Highway between Elsinore and San Juan Capistrano. The memorial site consists of a circular area containing a red Maltese cross. The next phase will be the completion of the Memorial centerpiece with the final phase to include finishing of the retaining wall followed by placement of the fire plaques. All funding for this memorial is derived solely from donations, contributions and service partnerships with an estimated completion cost of \$150,000. I urge the Board of Supervisors to approve this use of Community Improvement Designation Funds.
