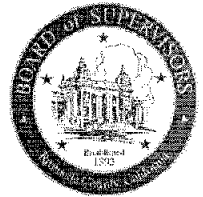

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the use of Community Improvement Designation funds for the California Wildland Firefighter Memorial, Inc.;
- 2) Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the following budget adjustments:

BACKGROUND: The California Wildland Firefighter Memorial is a tribute to the firefighters that have paid the ultimate sacrifice fighting wildland fires in the State of California. This memorial is located on its own designated highway; the Ortega Highway between Elsinore and San Juan Capistrano. The memorial site consists of a circular area containing a red Maltese cross. The next phase will be the completion of the Memorial centerpiece with the final phase to include finishing the retaining wall followed by placement of the fire plaques. All funding for this memorial is derived solely from donation, contributions and service partnerships with an estimated completion cost of \$150,000.

I request that the Board of Supervisors approve a contribution of \$5,000 to support the California Wildland Firefighter Memorial, Inc.
