RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve and:

1. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached Grant Agreement between DPSS and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the attached Saint Vincent De Paul Management, Inc.'s Supportive Housing Program Grant for \$525,000 for the period of December 1, 2008 through November 30, 2009;
2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached contract HU 3367-00, between DPSS and Saint Vincent De Paul Management, Inc.;
3. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to sign ministerial amendments with Saint Vincent De Paul Management, Inc. not to exceed the maximum amount of the Grant Agreement (\$525,000); and
4. Authorize the Director of DPSS to administer the agreement with Saint Vincent De Paul Management, Inc.

SUBJECT: HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT AGREEMENT—
SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL MANAGEMENT, INC.

BACKGROUND:

On May 16, 2007 (Agenda Item 3.32), the Board authorized DPSS to submit an application for Homeless Assistance funds to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, which included the renewal of the Martha's Village & Kitchen's (MVK) transitional housing program. This transitional housing is operated through a contract between Saint Vincent De Paul Management, Inc. and DPSS. The program is located in Indio.

The goal of this transitional housing program is to serve twenty-four (24) homeless families. Twenty-five (25) homeless single adults are also projected to be served. The types of service provided by this agreement include operations and supportive services. Anticipated outcomes for this program are that 61% of families and 61% of single adults exiting the program will move into permanent housing and that 50% of residents participating in Career Track will obtain, or maintain income. Additionally, 50% of adults identified with substance abuse will maintain sobriety for 4 months or more.

According to the Annual Progress Report submitted by Martha's Village & Kitchen, for the time period of 12/01/06 to 11/30/07, fifty-one (51) single adults, ninety-nine (99) adults in families and one hundred seventy-four (174) children in families entered the program. Thirty-seven (37) single adults, ninety-six (96) adults in families and one hundred sixty-eight (168) children in families exited the program. 95% of the families who exited the program moved to permanent housing. 61% of single adults who exited the program moved into permanent housing. 48% of the residents in Career Track, obtained or maintained income from employment, as measured at the time of program exit. Of the adults who identified with substance abuse, 44% maintained sobriety for 4 months or more, as measured at the time of program exit.

There are no changes to the persons to be served, the service site(s), or service modalities between this agreement and the expiring agreement.

The current one-year renewal expires on November 30, 2008.
