BACKGROUND: On April 24, 2008, the Local Area Formation Commission (LAFCO) approved Annexation 108 (LAFCO 2007-77-22). Annexation 108 is comprised of approximately 31 acres, generally located between Interstate 15 and State Street, on the north side of Foothill parkway. The property owner initiated the proceedings.

Compliance with terms and conditions set by LAFCO is required in order to complete the annexation. Specifically, the City of Corona is required to enter into a service agreement to provide police protection, fire protection, and the maintenance of a Starne Road in the unincorporated area west of the I-15 and north of the annexation area generally known as El Corrito. The requirement to provide police and fire protection is for five years following the recordation of the Certificate of Completion, or until the area is annexed, whichever occurs first. The requirement to maintain Starne Road is until such time as an alternate access is provided.

The attached agreement is a result of a collaborative effort between the County Fire, the Sheriff's Department, County Counsel, Executive Office, City of Corona Community Development Department, City of Corona Fire and Police Departments, and the city attorney.

The City of Corona City Council approved the agreement on November 5, 2008. It has been approved as form by County Counsel.
