**SUBJECT:** Airport Land Use Commission Consistency For March Air Reserve Base

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Request the Airport Land Use Commission staff to work with the March Operations Assurance Taskforce to recommend land use policies that affect March Joint Powers Authority member agencies; and
2. Direct the Executive Office to monitor the progress of this effort.

**BACKGROUND:** The Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC) is an advisory body whose mission is to protect and promote the public health, safety, and welfare of residents in the vicinity of the airports and of the users of the airports, while also ensuring the continued operation of the airports within its jurisdiction. The duties of ALUC include, but are not limited to, reviewing plans, regulations, and other actions of local agencies whose general plans are covered by an airport land use compatibility plan.

The county has become aware of a pending action by a local agency, the City of Perris, which is a city within the jurisdiction of ALUC, to overrule findings by ALUC. The county met with city staff and an agreement was reached to continue until January 2009 any actions with regard to overruling ALUC, to allow ALUC to work with the appropriate agencies on a possible resolution.
