**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Move that the Board of Supervisors:

- (1) assess the reasonable costs of abatement of a public nuisance (excess outside storage and one substandard mobile home) in the above-referenced matter to be thirty thousand, one hundred, twenty-one dollars and sixty-one cents (US \$30,121.61)
- (2) assess the costs of abatement against the above-described subject property;
- (3) authorize the recordation of a notice of abatement lien; and
- (4) authorize the abatement costs to be added to the tax roll as a special assessment.

**BACKGROUND:** Government Code § 25845, Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 (RCC Title 17), 457 (RCC Title 15) and 725 (RCC Chapter 1.16) and Section 1618, Article 10, Title 25 of the California Code of Regulations, provide authority for the recovery of abatement costs in public nuisance cases, the recordation of a notice of abatement lien and inclusion of abatement costs on the tax roll as a special assessment upon approval of the Board of Supervisors.

Statement of Expense [Case No. CV 02-4682]  
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On July 17, 2003, the Code Enforcement Department issued a Ten-Day Notice of Intent to Abate a substandard mobile home on the subject property, which was deemed to be an imminent hazard. On February 9, 2004, one substandard mobile home was abated from the subject property by the Riverside County Code Enforcement Department pursuant to a seizure warrant.

The Board of Supervisors issued an Order to Abate in this case regarding the excess outside storage of materials on the property on October 28, 2003. On January 8, 2007 the excess outside storage of materials was abated from the subject property by the Riverside County Code Enforcement Department pursuant to a seizure warrant.

All notices regarding the Statement of Expense hearing have been given to Reba Waddle, the property owner, as required by law (see attached exhibits).
