SUBJECT: MOU – REES Initiative

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BACKGROUND:

This project will explore the assumption that place-based strategies to reduce poverty and enhance economic security are more effective when they take the racial inequalities that are a result of structural racism into account in their program design.

CAP Riverside was one of eight agencies selected to participate in this initiative. These agencies will run community initiatives to implement racial equity analyses in its community, educate and mobilize its community, and refine and adapt its program strategies based on this analysis.

In Riverside County, CAP Riverside will build a community coalition with the goal of eliminating racial disparity in Family Daycare Licensing by 2010.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: No County General Funds will be required. A budget adjustment of \$2,500 is necessary for Fiscal Year 2008/2009. The remaining balance of \$2,500 will be included in Fiscal Year 2009/2010 through the normal budget process.
