**BACKGROUND:** The Transportation Improvement Program provides for the construction of the subject improvements. The intersection meets the established warrants for the construction of a traffic signal, which will provide protected traffic movements and improve traffic and pedestrian safety.

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Traffic signal operation and maintenance costs will be incurred by the City of Norco after the signal is built and a notice of completion has been filed.

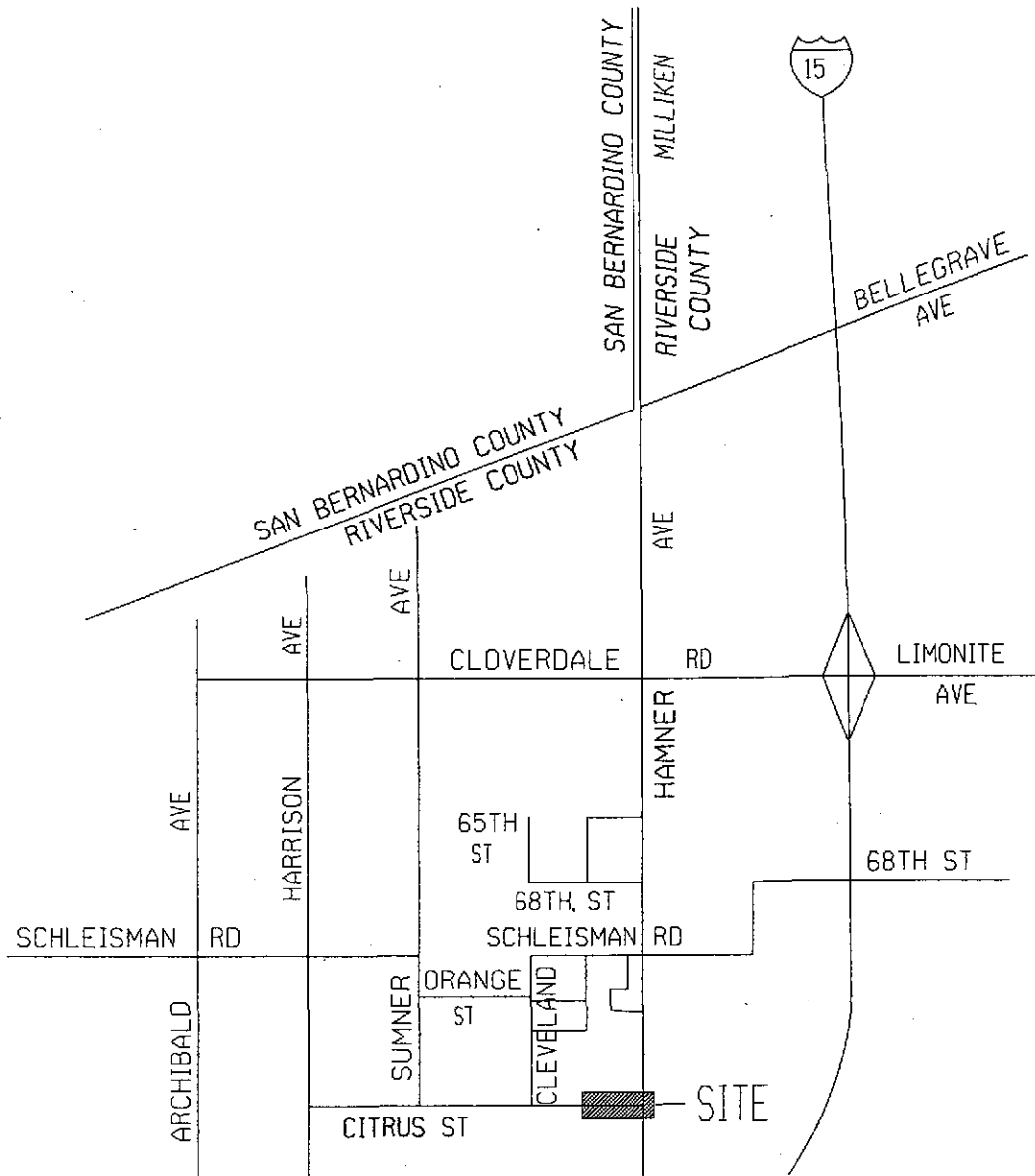
The Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659.6, allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities.

The original project scope of work included the widening of the intersection to its ultimate width by use of TUMF funds. However, current cash flow shortages in the Northwest TUMF zone has required that we down-scale the immediate project. Consequently, the scope of this project was reduced to include one through lane in each direction on Hamner.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental clearance is complete.
