

**BACKGROUND:**

The Boy Scouts of America, Friends of Scouting Council, honors a Citizen of the Year each year, this year honoring Supervisor Buster. These funds support the Citizen of the Year event. The Moreno Valley Hispanic Chamber of Commerce holds an Annual Installation Dinner. These funds sponsor that event. San Geronio Pass Hispanic Chamber of Commerce holds an annual Christmas Toy Drive providing Christmas for underprivileged children. These funds support that event. The Beaumont/Cherry Valley Park and Recreation District needs assistance to provide funding to upgrade the Cherry Valley grange Hall kitchen and restrooms. The Smile Factory Foundation provides dental screening and care for children 0-17 who have never seen a dentist.
