**SUBJECT:** Ratify Agreement No. 08-85312 California Department of Public Health (CDPH) and the Department of Public Health, Disease Control Branch, Pediatric Immunization Program

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify acceptance of Award No. 08-85312 with the State of California Department of Health Services for the Pediatric Immunization Program for the performance period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009 for a total amount of \$439,591,
- 2) Authorize Chairman of the Board to sign eight (8) copies of the Agreement.

**BACKGROUND:** The Immunization Project was established to ensure adequate Immunization of Riverside County children against vaccine-preventable childhood diseases. The goal of this program is to raise and maintain immunization rates of 90% or better for our children by age 2 years and 95% or better for our school-age children kindergarten through grade 12.

**BACKGROUND:** (Continued).

The national recommendations are age-appropriate immunizations for polio, diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, measles, mumps, rubella, hepatitis B, hepatitis A, chickenpox, Hemophilus influenza type B, and invasive pneumococcal disease. In collaboration with WIC, parent education classes are given at WIC sites to stress the importance of timely immunizations for their children. This is a State mandated program.

Pursuant to Board Policy A-30, the positions funded by this grant will be eliminated should the funded be discontinued.

Fiscal Year 2008/2009 submitted budget included this amount; No budget adjustment is requested at this time.
