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BACKGROUND:

The Smile Factory provides no cost urgent and essential dental care to children from low income families, ages 4-11, attending the Palm Springs, Desert Sands and Coachella Valley Unified School Districts. They operate a mobile dental clinic that visits elementary schools that have 70% or more children receiving free or reduced lunch. Through their oral hygiene education and screening program, they reached approximately 17,000 children and through their preventative and restorative dental procedures they reached 5000 kids throughout the Coachella Valley.

We would like to use Fourth District Community Improvement funds to support this program.
