BACKGROUND:

On November 4, 2008 the Board approved in-principle the installation of new camera and lighting systems to enhance safety and security at the Probation Juvenile Hall Detention Center in Indio. Facilities Management has established a project to design and construct both systems including a remodel of the control room and building a new server room.

Facilities Management solicited proposals from engineering firms for the proposed work. MRC Engineering Inc. was selected based on their proposed solution and cost. MRC Engineering has extensive experience and expertise in both design and installation of security systems and lighting.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the agreement as to legal form.

Sufficient funds have been budgeted for FY 2008/2009 within the project budget to support the engineering services agreement. All costs associated with this project will be funded through Capital Improvement Fund and Probation Department Funds.
