SUBJECT: AMENDMENT # 4 TO THE AGREEMENTS WITH ALTERNATIVES TO DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND SHELTER FROM THE STORM

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve:

1. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached Amendment No.4 to the Agreements between Riverside County Department of Public Social Services (DPSS), Alternatives to Domestic Violence and Shelter from the Storm, to provide Domestic Abuse Advocacy Intervention Services. The Amendments extend the term from July 01, 2007 through June 30, 2009 and increases the MRA's to \$466,181.00 for Alternatives to Domestic Violence and \$258,328.00 for Shelter from the Storm.
2. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to approve ministerial amendments and exercise renewal options for an amount not to exceed the maximum reimbursable amounts.
3. Authorize the Director of DPSS to administer the terms of these Agreements.

TO: BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

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AND SHELTER FROM THE STORM**

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BACKGROUND:

DPSS currently contracts with Alternatives to Domestic Violence (ADV) and Shelter from the Storm (SFTS) to provide domestic abuse advocacy services to CalWORKs applicants and recipients throughout Riverside County. Services under these contracts includes case management, individual counseling, referrals to medical and social services, relocation assistance and emergency shelter, parenting programs, temporary restraining order assistance, court accompaniment and life skills training, which include financial planning, anger management, and coping with stress.

On May 5, 2008, DPSS released Request for Proposal (RFP) DPARC-110 seeking competitive proposals from qualified vendors to provide Domestic Violence Advocacy Intervention Services for CalWORKs applicants and recipients.

In order to ensure continuity of services during the RFP process, DPSS requested approval to amend the existing agreements with ADV and SFTS to extend the term and increase the funding for that period.

DPSS received two responses to the RFP, only one of which was fully responsive. DPSS proceeded to negotiate with the one bidder; however, the proposal was cost prohibitive and we were not able to come to mutually acceptable terms.

As a result, DPSS found it necessary to close this RFP and is planning to re-issue the RFP with a modified and clarified scope of work, which we believe will result in more responsive and cost effective proposals.

In the meantime, DPSS requests that the existing agreements with ADV and SFTS again be amended to extend the term to June 30, 2009 with additional funding for this period of time.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The Contracts will be funded with Federal, State, and County Funds. Total contract cost and revenue were included in the FY08/09 budget.
