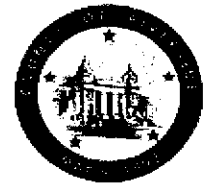

SUBJECT: FY09 Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Grant Program

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:
Authorize County Fire – OES to apply for the EOC grant program up to \$250,000 for EOC spatial planning.

BACKGROUND: The FY09 EOC grant program is intended to improve emergency management and preparedness capabilities by supporting flexible, sustainable, secure and interoperable EOCs with a focus on addressing identified deficiencies and needs. County Fire - OES would like to submit an application for this grant to contract services to evaluate the existing space and create a plan that will allow us to better utilize the current EOC space. The plan will give us a starting place to make future improvements to the EOC and will provide necessary documentation to apply for additional grants in the future. This grant has a 25% match requirement which will be met as a soft match utilizing time of County Fire –OES employees and County Fire finance personnel.
