AC sidewalk on the north side of 68<sup>th</sup> Street. The proposed sidewalk will link the existing sidewalk on the 68<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge to the existing sidewalk west of Pats Ranch Road and provide a safe path of travel to VanderMolen Elementary School. Additional safety improvements associated with the sidewalk include replacement of the existing chain link fence on the north side of the bridge with a taller, arched top fence, installation of a chain link fence on the south side of the bridge where there is currently no fence, additional chain link fencing adjacent to the bridge, new striping to Wells Spring Street and new crosswalks at Wells Spring Street.

VanderMolen School is scheduled to open on July 1, 2009. The project is partially funded with State SR2S funds for which the County successfully competed. The funding allocation is still being processed through the State and should be in place prior to the award for construction.

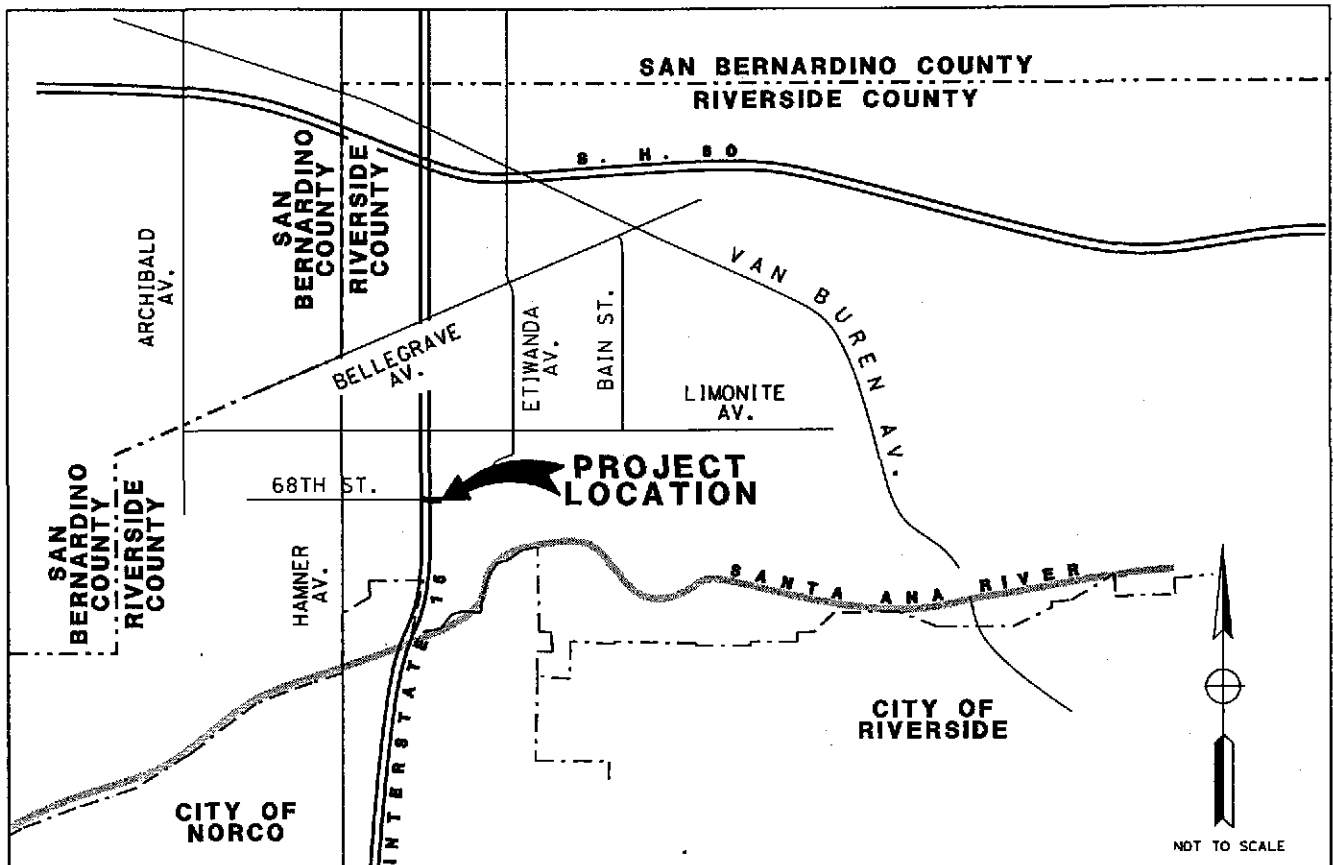
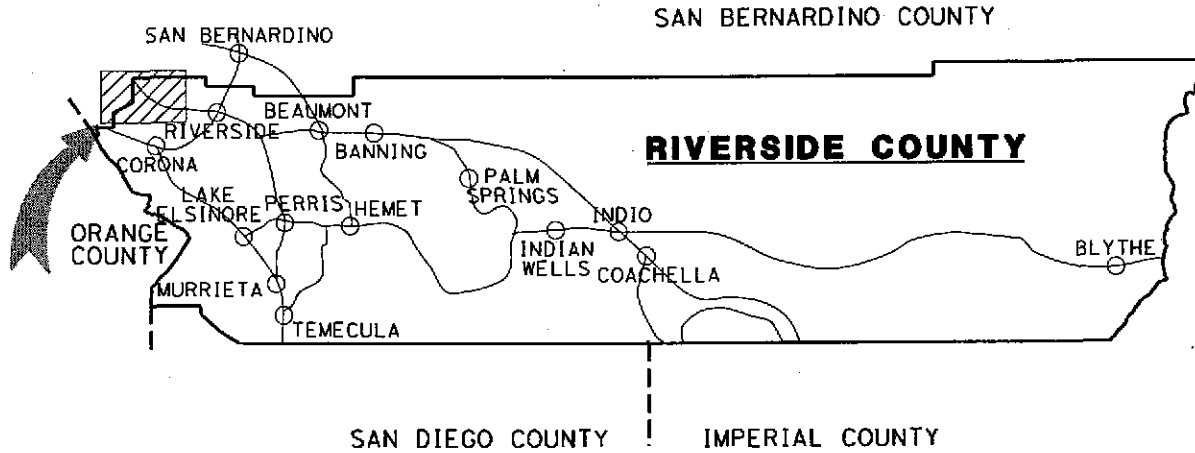
The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.
