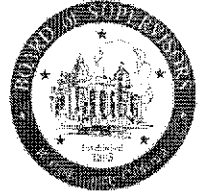

SUBJECT: Amending the structure of the Temescal Canyon Municipal Advisory Council

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board joins me in adopting Resolution No. 2009-047 which will amend the structure of the Temescal Canyon Municipal Advisory Council

BACKGROUND: On June 30, 1998 the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 98-220 which established the Temescal Canyon Municipal Advisory Council, naming representatives from specific Homeowners Associations (HOA's). Due to the growth in the community over the past 10 years including many new HOA's it was determined necessary to remove the names of the specific HOA's allowing a broader spectrum of the community to participate.

The community has also decided to be named Temescal Valley. Therefore, the name is changed from Temescal Canyon Municipal Advisory Council to Temescal Valley Municipal Advisory Council.

5 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE
6 AMENDING THE STRUCTURE OF THE
7 TEMESCAL CANYON MUNICIPAL ADVISORY COUNCIL

8 WHEREAS, on June 30, 1998, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 98-220
9 establishing the Temescal Canyon Municipal Advisory Council for the purpose of advising the Board of
10 Supervisors on matters including, but not limited to, public health, safety, welfare, public works and
11 planning; and

12 WHEREAS, it is now deemed desirable and appropriate for the name and structure of the Temescal
13 Canyon Municipal Advisory Council to be modified and updated; now therefore,

14 BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside,
15 State of California, in regular session assembled on February 24, 2009, that the name of the Temescal
16 Canyon Municipal Advisory Council is hereby changed to the **Temescal Valley Municipal Advisory**
17 **Council** (hereinafter referred to as the "Temescal Valley MAC").

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the membership of the Temescal Valley
19 MAC is hereby *reduced* from seven (7) regular members and two (2) alternate members to **five (5) regular**
20 **members and one (1) alternate member**. All members shall be at least eighteen (18) years of age, and
21 shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that every effort shall be made to include four (4)
23 regular members who are residents or landowners within the Temescal Valley MAC territory. One (1)
24 regular member shall be from the commercial business or mining or heavy industrial uses sector in the
25 Temescal Valley MAC territory.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that all provisions of previous Resolution
27 No. 98-220 not otherwise affected by this amending resolution shall remain the same. This amending
28 resolution is effective upon adoption by the Board of Supervisors.
