**SUBJECT: DONATION OF SURPLUS MODULAR BUILDING TO COACHELLA VALLEY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT**

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize the Director of Purchasing to donate the surplus Mecca Library module to the Coachella Valley Unified School District.

**BACKGROUND:** In January 1988, the County entered into an agreement with the Coachella Valley Unified School District to place a County owned module building on District property to house the Mecca Library. The modular building was purchased with Community Development Block Grant Funds. With the establishment of a new and larger library located on Avenue 66 in Mecca, the modular is now empty and the ground lease with the District has expired. The old modular serves no useful purpose to the County and would be too costly to move to a new site. Therefore, we seek Board approval to donate the modular to the Coachella Valley Unified School District, who will be able to refurbish and utilize it for their school needs. There is no cost to the County for this action.
