SUBJECT: Appointment to the Indian gaming Local Community Benefit Committee

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors appoint Gene Gilbert, of the Indio City Council, to the Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee.

BACKGROUND: In accordance with SB 621 (Battin and Burton), on December 16, 2003, the Board of Supervisors appointed three city and two county representatives and one alternate in each category to the Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee (CBC). Mike Wilson, City of Indio, was included in the appointments.

Mr. Wilson's elected term on the Indio City Council ended, creating a vacancy on the Committee. The city alternate representative was moved into the city representative vacancy and Gene Gilbert, City of Indio, is being recommended to fill the city alternate vacancy. Mr. Gilbert has served on the Indio City Council for the last eight yeas and recently ended a year term as Mayor.

The role of the CBC is to allocate funds from the Indian Gaming Special Distribution Fund (SDF) to local government agencies for the purpose of mitigating impacts of Tribal gaming.
