SUBJECT: FY08 Buffer Zone Protection Grant Program

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Accept the FY08 Buffer Zone Protection Grant Program (BZPP) award in the amount of \$193,030 on behalf of Riverside County Operational Area;
2. Adoption of Riverside County Resolution Number 2009-080, designation of Authorized Agents and Project Acceptance under the FY08 BZPP;
3. Authorize the Auditor-Controller to adjust appropriations and estimated revenue as outlined in Schedule A.

BACKGROUND: The California Emergency Management Agency (CalEMA), the Office of Domestic Preparedness, and the Department of Homeland Security Information Analysis and Infrastructure Protection Directorate provide protective action BZPP equipment and management funding to Operational Areas to protect and secure critical infrastructure and key resource sites across the country. BZPP is designed to reduce vulnerabilities to sites by extending the protected area around a site into the surrounding community and supporting the prevention and preparedness efforts of local law enforcement first responders. Riverside County Operational Area applied for and will receive pass-through funding on behalf of the first responders in the City of Riverside's Police Department to harden a federally-determined law enforcement sensitive critical infrastructure in Riverside County.
