RE: Amendment No. 3 to the Engineering Services Agreement with SC Engineering for On-Call Engineering Services

February 11, 2009

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On April 27, 2004, the Board of Supervisors executed an agreement between the County and SC Engineering that authorized SC Engineering to perform engineering support services for the Transportation Department. The agreement provided the Transportation Department with the authority to approve consulting services up to a maximum of \$500,000 per year over a three year period with the option of providing up to two one-year extensions. On April 24, 2007 (1st Amendment) and April 29, 2008 (2nd Amendment) the Board executed amendments that provided one year extensions for the Transportation Department to authorize these services.

This amendment will extend the expiration date to allow SC Engineering to complete work assignments that have already been approved by the Transportation Department but are not yet complete. All work performed during the extended contract period will be subject to the original authorizations provided by the Transportation Department and no additional budget authorization is requested.

All associated contract costs would be fully funded by Gas Tax, Measure "A" TUMF fees, RBBD fees, Developer fees and Permit fees. Thus, no Net County costs would be incurred as a result of this contract amendment.

County Counsel has approved this amendment as to form.
