9 **WHEREAS**, the hereinafter described road was offered for road right of way purposes
10 per Record of Survey hereinafter-referred to, which offer of dedication has not been
11 previously accepted for public use by the County of Riverside, now, therefore;

13 **BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED** by the Board of Supervisors of
14 the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on March 17 ,
15 2009, that this Board accepts the offer of dedication and recognizes that said road is a public
16 road open for use by the general public;

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED** that this acceptance
19 is for the purpose of vesting title in the County of Riverside on behalf of the public for public
20 road and utility uses, and is not an acceptance of the road into the County Maintained Road
21 System pursuant to Section 941 of the Streets and Highways Code and that said road will not
22 become part of the County Maintained Road System unless subsequently accepted into said
23 Maintained Road System by a resolution adopted by this Board;

6 All that portion of Winesap Avenue (varies in width) as shown on Record of Survey
