SUBJECT: Extension of AB 2766 Memorandum of Understanding with the Coachella Valley Association of Governments (CVAG) for Air Quality Services, Second Amendment.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the Second Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) as attached.
2. Authorize the Chairman to sign the agreement on behalf of the County.
3. Return an original copy of the extended MOU to CVAG.

BACKGROUND: AB 2766 specifies that \$4.00 from each vehicle registered in California be used to reduce air pollution from motor vehicles and for related planning, monitoring, enforcement, and technical studies that assist with implementation of the California Clean Air Act of 1988. Funds are distributed by a formula that takes into account the population of a given area. Riverside County uses AB 2766 funds, estimated at \$700,000 for FY 08/09, to support the Ride Share Program and air quality efforts by CVAG and the Western Regional Council of Governments (WRCOG). The County and nine cities of the Coachella Valley participate in a mandatory program to reduce particulate matter (PM10) and move the area into compliance with standards established by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). To accomplish air quality tasks, the County and the nine cities entered into an agreement with CVAG to provide funding for the match on a federal street sweeping program and to support staff costs associated with a variety of air quality efforts in the Coachella Valley.

The initial MOU (3.2 of 7/13/04) and First Amendment (3.2 of 11/27/07) provided CVAG with 45 percent of the County's AB 2766 allocation after the population of the unincorporated area was factored into the formula. Without the MOU, CVAG would have been eligible for 33 percent of the County's unincorporated area funding based upon the population of the Coachella Valley. The MOU raised the amount to 45 percent from the County of Riverside and each of the nine cities in the Coachella Valley (collectively referred to as the CVAG Member Jurisdictions.) This action by the Board of Supervisors will continue this agreement until June 30, 2009.

This amendment was requested by CVAG in November 2008, the paperwork was inadvertently misplaced causing the delay in this submittal.

County Counsel has approved the extension as to form.
