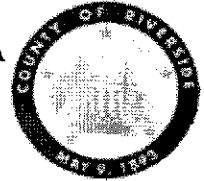

1. Approve the attached agreement with International Pavement Solutions, Inc. of Mentone, California, in the amount of \$154,079 and authorize the Chairman to execute the agreement on behalf of the County;
2. Delegate project management authority for this project to the Director of Facilities Management in accordance with applicable Board Policies.

BACKGROUND : On December 9, 2008, the Board of Supervisors approved the plans and specifications for Street Improvements in Desert Hot Springs on Palm Drive, and authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids. On January 7, 2009, ten contractors attended a mandatory job walk.
