BACKGROUND (Cont.):

This amendment to the agreement is to exercise the option to license the applications of Zynx Orders and ZynxCare.

The cost offered for this was in the original agreement and in overall project cost with no additional funding required.

ZynxOrders is an advanced content management system for developing and maintaining evidence-based order sets, alerts, and reminders. ZynxOrders content is based on a timely and rigorous review of medical research, performance measures, and regulatory standards. All clinical summaries and supporting evidence are fully referenced and individually classified based on a clearly defined research methodology.

ZynxCare enables nurses and interdisciplinary nurse teams to incorporate evidence-based practices without interrupting workflow and care processes. The 150+ plan of care templates in ZynxCare are based on the latest evidence, regulatory guidelines, and performance measures. The templates are fully customizable and allow for integration in your workflow within the Hospital Information System.

ZynxCare includes plan of care templates, flowsheets, and education checklists with links to the underlying evidence. ZynxCare will be used to demonstrate compliance with organizations such as The Joint Commission.

ZynxOrders and ZynxCare are implementation accelerators that will reduce the time to build clinical orders and clinical documentation by nine (9) months.
