Whereas, immediately prior to being appointed to her current post, she served as the Managing Director of the Riverside County Economic Development Agency for ten years and in that capacity, Ms. Zimpfer served as the Chief Operating Officer of EDA; and

Whereas, during her tenure as the Assistant County Executive Officer for Economic Development, Ms. Zimpfer was responsible for business retention, business relocations and expansion of a number of businesses to the County of Riverside increasing wages, investments and creating higher paying jobs for our workforce; and

Whereas, Robin Zimpfer has led the charge for the County Economic Development Agency to construct fire stations, sheriff's stations, parks, community centers, libraries, senior centers, community pools, gymnasiums and other facilities that improved public safety and added sorely needed amenities to virtually every community within the county; and

Whereas, Robin Zimpfer began her career with the County of Riverside in 1985 with the County Development Department and during her service to the County of Riverside, Ms. Zimpfer has contributed greatly to the economic growth of the county with an overall impact of \$42.5 billion; and

Whereas, Robin Zimpfer has also been a champion for numerous charities including the fight for early detection and prevention of breast cancer and finding a cure for autism. For her charitable work, she has received several awards including the prestigious Thomas Jefferson Award for Public Service; and

Whereas, Robin Zimpfer has also served in a variety of professional associations, civic organizations, public policy boards during her career on the local, county and state levels.
