BACKGROUND: The Transportation Improvement Program provides for the construction of the subject improvements. The proposed traffic signal meets traffic signal warrants and it will improve safety by providing protected traffic movements and pedestrian crossing.

This project also involves consistently striping 65th Avenue for two through lanes in each direction with left turn pockets at intersections between Archibald to East of Cleveland and to allow parking in front of the park at Cleveland and 65th.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 for this location, to be funded from gas tax.

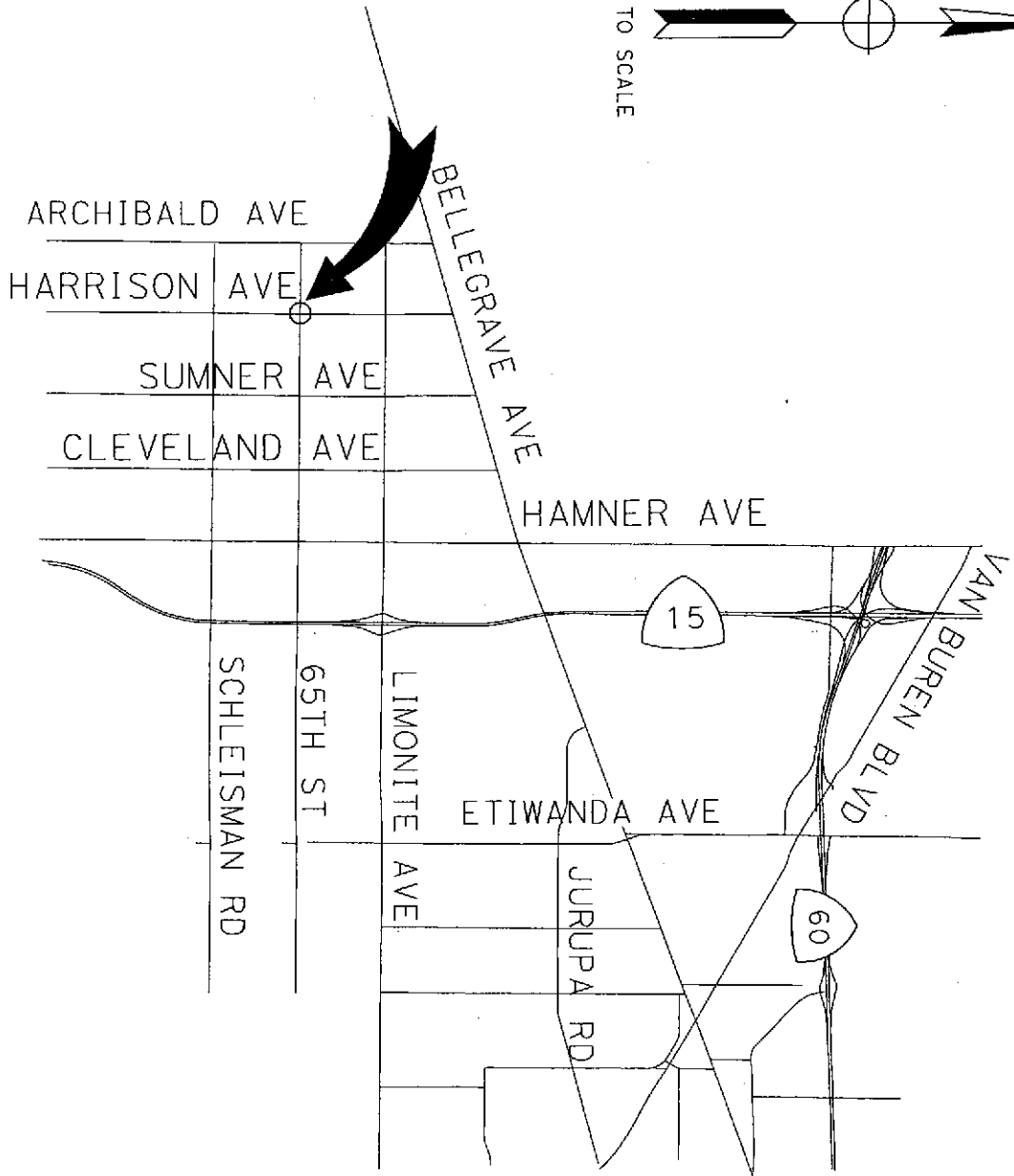
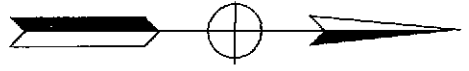
The Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659.6, allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities.
