**SUBJECT:** Renaming the Sun City Library

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors rename the newly renovated Sun City Library to the "Jeff Stone Community Library"

**BACKGROUND:** This project has been planned since 2006 and, as one of the busiest libraries in the county it was in need of more space. Supervisor Stone worked with the community, the County Librarian and the Economic Development Agency to put together the needed financial resources and purchased additional property to see this needed community facility was realized for the Sun City community in the new City of Menifee.

Currently under construction, the new library will have almost 11,000 square feet, an increase of 4,000 square feet, and will feature state-of-the-art equipment and the latest environmentally sound technology. In addition to a larger children's area, more shelving for books, there will be a larger community room and more computers.

In honor of Supervisor Stone's dedication to public service and his commitment to improving education and higher learning, it is most appropriate for this newly renovated library to bear his name in perpetuity.
