BACKGROUND:

The City of Chino and the County of Riverside share a signal at Hellman Avenue and Pine Avenue/Schleisman. In order to provide efficiencies in the maintenance of the location, the City will provide the maintenance while the County will pay for the electrical services. This Agreement will provide the framework for any future signals that are jointly shared and the County will pay for electrical costs or provide the signal maintenance. Future amendments will be mutually agreed on by the City's Public Works Director and the County's Director of Transportation. There are sufficient funds available to fund all costs under this Agreement.
