RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Chairman execute the Quitclaim Deed.

BACKGROUND: The Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC), in conjunction with the State of California (Caltrans), is making improvements to I-215 that will require additional right-of-way. This parcel was quitclaimed to the County from Caltrans in May 1973 at no cost as excess right-of-way not needed for the freeway at that time, which is now necessary for the next phase of the freeway work. The execution of the Quitclaim Deed will transfer the parcel to RCTC for that work.

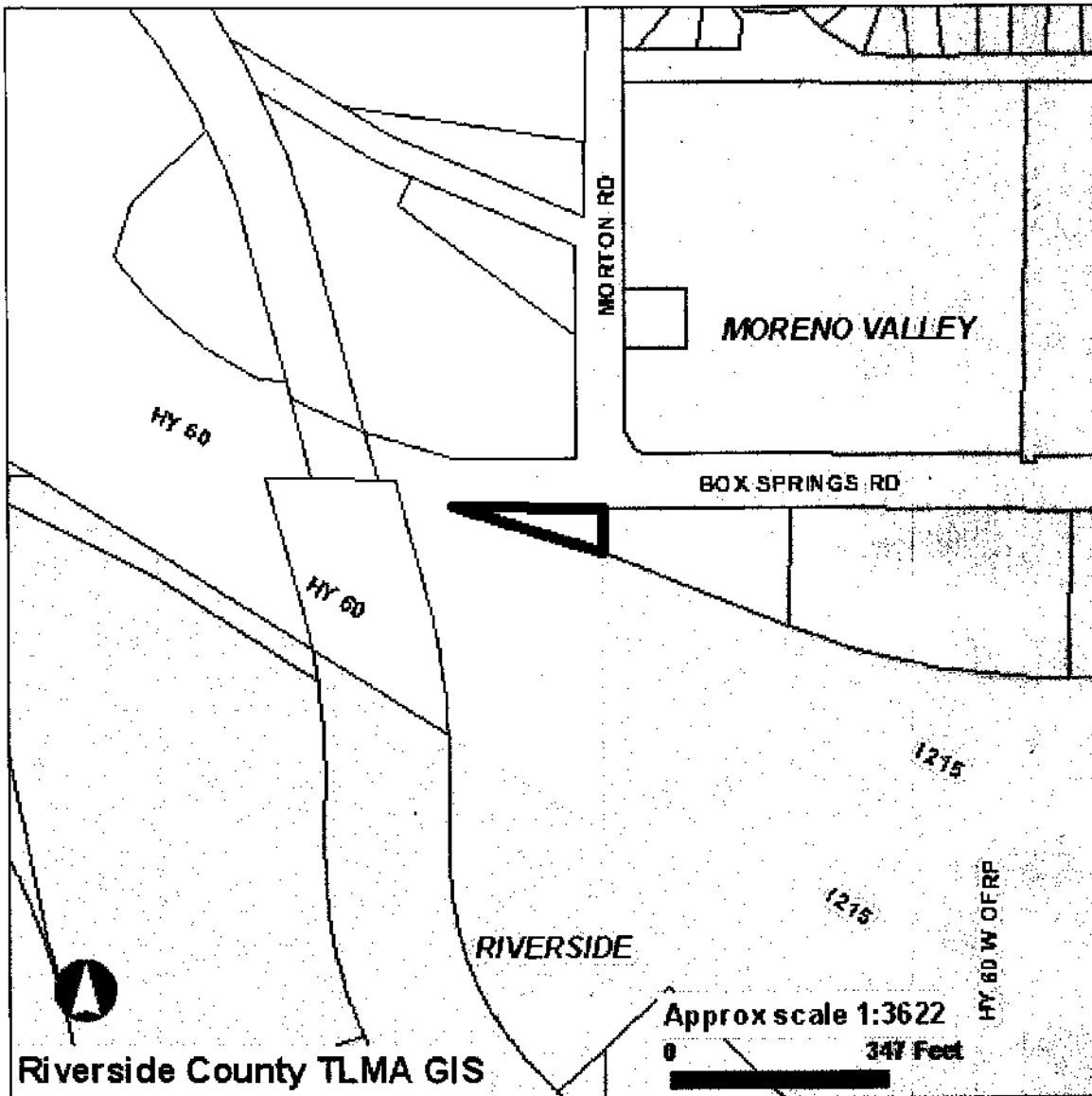
