

**SUBJECT:** Construction of regional trail on Bain Street, 450' North of Limonite Avenue to Galena Street, Mira Loma area.

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors approve the plans and specifications for the construction of regional trail on Bain Street, 450' North of Limonite Avenue to Galena Street, Mira Loma area. Authorize the Clerk to advertise for bids to be received in the office of the Director of Transportation up to the hour of 2:00 pm, Wednesday, April 22, 2009 at which time bids will be opened.

**BACKGROUND:** The proposed trail is located about 35' from the existing edge of pavement and includes the construction of a 10 foot wide decomposed granite (DG) path, a wood post fence and associated improvements within the 2-mile long segment along the west side of the San Sevaine Channel's existing chain link fence.

RE: Construction of regional trail on Bain Street, 450' North of Limonite Avenue to Galena Street, Mira Loma area.

March 30, 2009

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The project is necessary to provide a usable and safe regional trail to connect to designated trails on either side of the project.

The Riverside County Transportation Department (County) is performing the design and construction services for this project.

By minute order dated March 3, 2009 (Agenda item 3.31) the Board approved the project's funding agreement between the County and the Regional Parks and Open Space District (Parks). Parks has "Development Impact Fees" to fund the entire cost of this project.

The Parks, County and Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) will enter into a separate agreement (License Agreement). This agreement will allow the use of County and District right-of-way to be used for the regional trail. The operation and maintenance of the existing flood control facilities including the San Sevaine Channel will remain the District's responsibility. However, the operation and maintenance of the trail and its appurtenance will be the Park District's responsibility.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

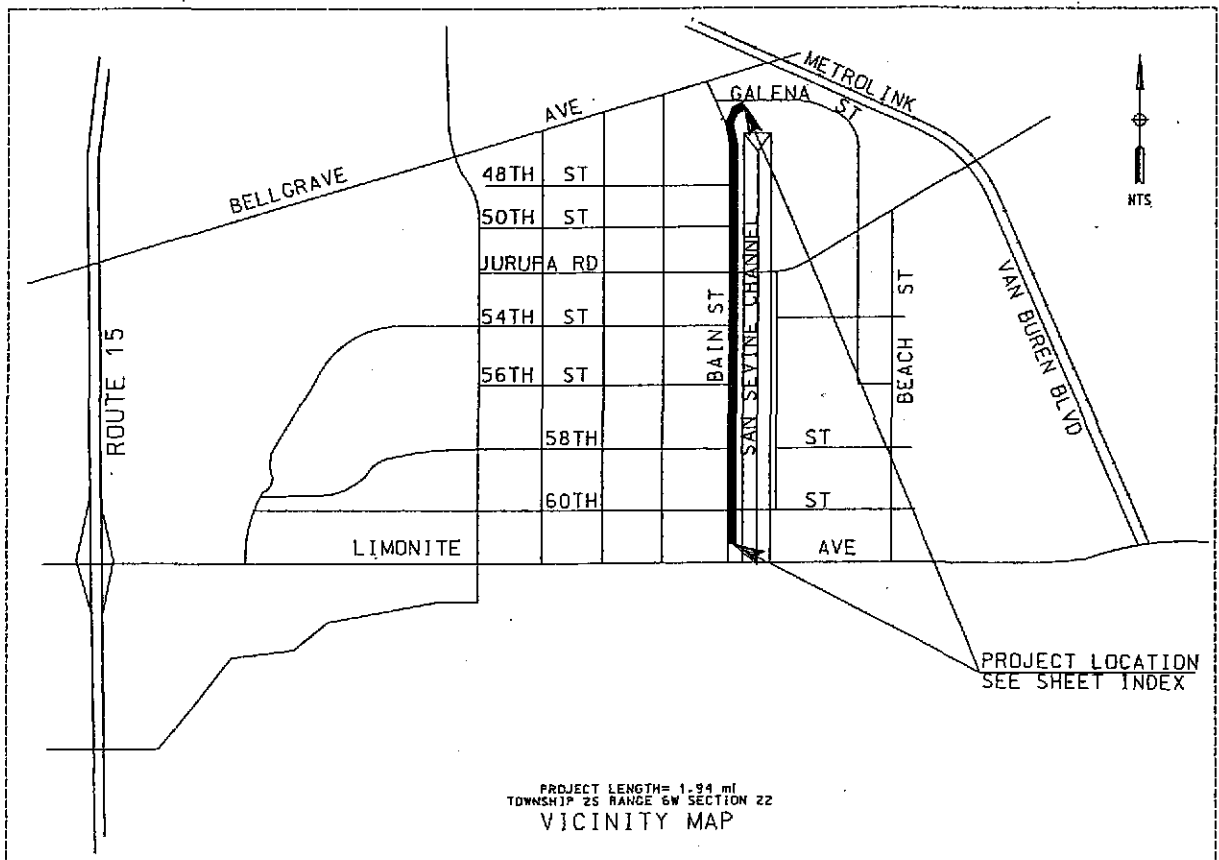
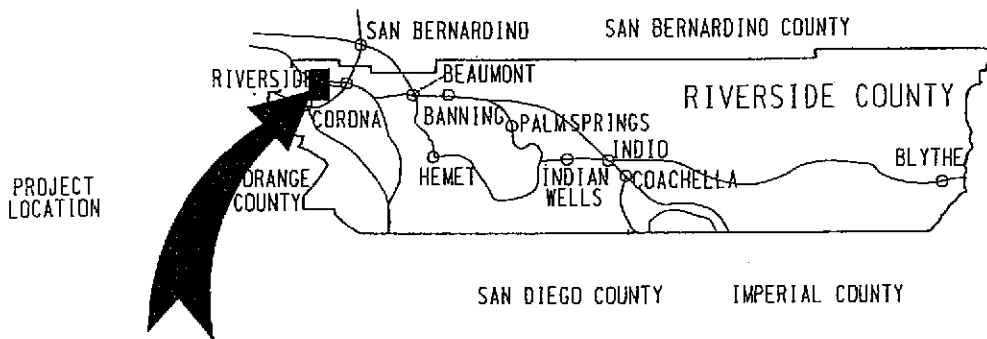
