3 Section 3. Section 6. subsection C. of Ordinance No. 510 is amended to read as
4 follows:

5 “C. The decision of an assessment hearing officer on an assessment appeal application
6 constitutes the final administrative decision of the county board of equalization or
7 county assessment appeals board on that application without any further action by
8 the county board of equalization or county assessment appeals board.”

9 Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.
