SUBJECT: Exempt Management, Management, Confidential, and Other Unrepresented Employees Salaries and Benefits Recommendation and Adoption of Resolution No. 2009-120

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve Resolution No. 2009-120, A Resolution of the County of Riverside and Other Agencies Providing Salaries and Related Matters for Exempt Management, Management, Confidential, and Other Unrepresented Employees, to replace and supersede Resolution No. 2008-487.

BACKGROUND: In accordance with the direction of your Board on April 7, 2009, Resolution No. 2009-120 is being placed on the consent calendar for adoption. The Resolution excludes the amended language previously submitted related to Article 5, Section 503(L)(i) which proposed an increase to the 401(a) contributions for the classification of County Executive Officer from \$338 per bi-weekly pay period to \$921 per bi-weekly pay period in lieu of a of 5.5% merit increase. The 5.5% merit increase is suspended, and the bi-weekly contribution for the classification shall remain at the current level of \$338, the level of 401(a) contributions granted to the CEO upon appointment on July 31, 2008.

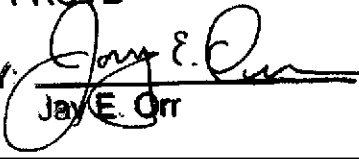
