SUBJECT: Recommendation for Distribution of Excess Proceeds for Tax Sale No. 176, Item 77.
Last assessed to: Lorraine Crawford.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the claim from Global Discoveries, Ltd., assignee for William Gene Crawford, heir to the Estate of Lorraine Crawford AKA Letha Lorraine Hedman, last assessee for payment of excess proceeds resulting from the Tax Collector's public auction sale associated with parcel 345150008-2;
- 2) Authorize and direct the Auditor-Controller to issue a warrant to Global Discoveries, Ltd., assignee for William Gene Crawford, heir to the Estate of Lorraine Crawford AKA Letha Lorraine Hedman in the amount of \$5,757.93, no sooner than ninety days from the date of this order, unless pursuant to the California Revenue and Taxation Code Section 4675, an appeal has been filed in Superior Court.

BACKGROUND: In accordance with Section 3691 et seq. of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, and with prior approval of the Board of Supervisors, the Tax Collector conducted the March 13, 2006 public auction sale. The deed conveying title to the purchasers at the auction was recorded May 3, 2006. Further, as required by Section 4676 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, notice of the right to claim excess proceeds was given on June 5, 2006, to parties of interest as defined in Section 4675 of said code. Parties of interest have been determined by an examination of lot book reports as well as Assessor's and Recorder's records, and various research methods were used to obtain current mailing addresses for these parties of interest.

The Treasurer-Tax Collector has received one claim for excess proceeds:

- 1) Claim from Global Discoveries, Ltd., assignee for William Gene Crawford based on an Assignment of Right to Collect Excess Proceeds dated August 10, 2006, a Quitclaim Deed recorded August 11, 1976 as Instrument No. 118355, a Declaration for Collection of Personal Property under California Probate Code 13100-13106 dated August 10, 2006 and the death certificate's of Letha Lorraine Hedman AKA: Lorraine Crawford and John Hedman.

Pursuant to Section 4675 (a) & (b) of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, it is the recommendation of this office that Global Discoveries, Ltd., assignee for William Gene Crawford, heir to the Estate of Lorraine Crawford AKA Letha Lorraine Hedman be awarded excess proceeds in the amount of \$5,757.93. Since there are no other claimants the excess proceeds in the amount of \$11,515.87 will remain unclaimed. Supporting documentation has been provided.
