SUBJECT: Mountain View Road Guard Rail Project, in the Desert Hot Springs area.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board accept the low bid of Trinity Construction of Blue Jay, CA in the amount of \$86,440. Award the contract to that firm and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the contract documents.

BACKGROUND: By Minute Order dated December 23, 2008 (agenda item 3.38) the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the Installation of metal beam guard railing, asphalt concrete dike and associated improvements on Mountain View Road in the Desert Hot Springs area. Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, January 14, 2009. Three bids were received. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest and best total bid was submitted by Trinity Construction of Blue Jay, CA in the amount of \$86,440.

The project will improve roadway safety within the project limits by providing a metal beam guard rail which is a warranted improvement.

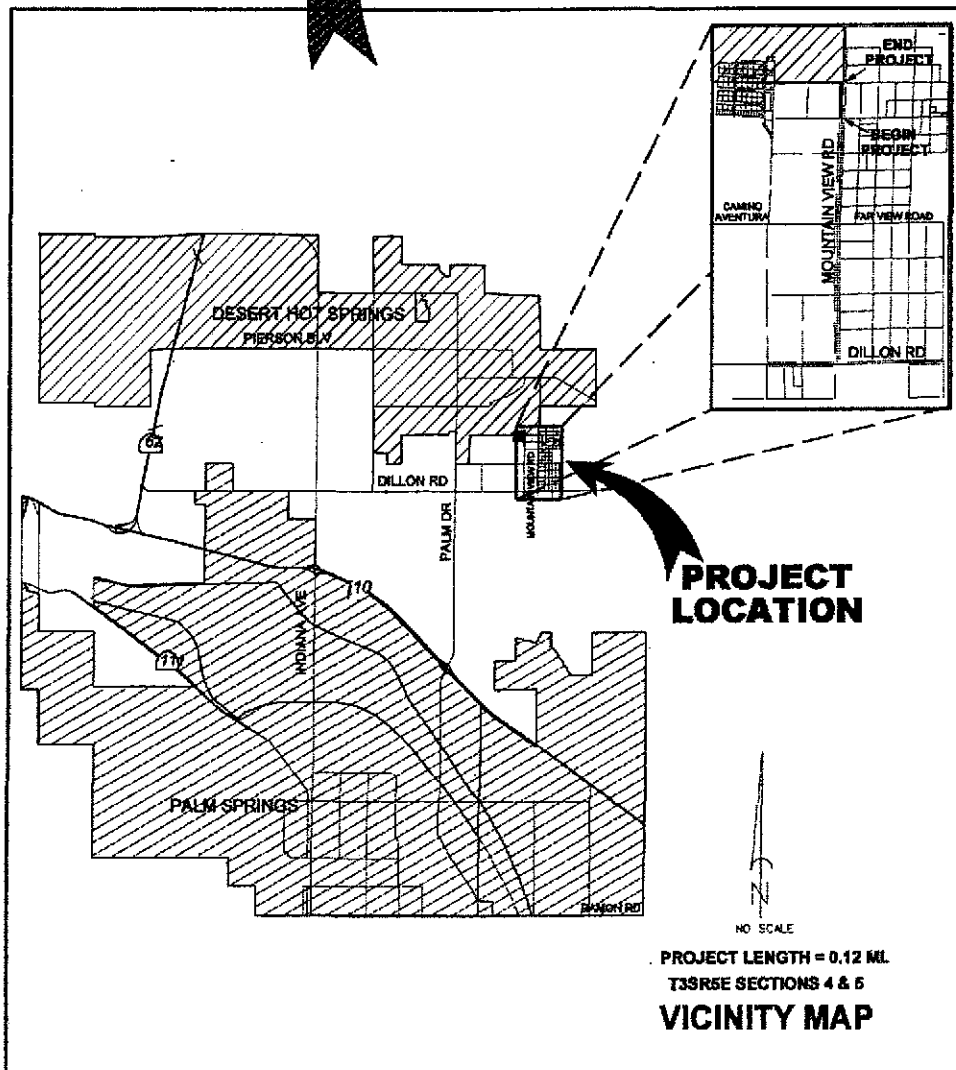
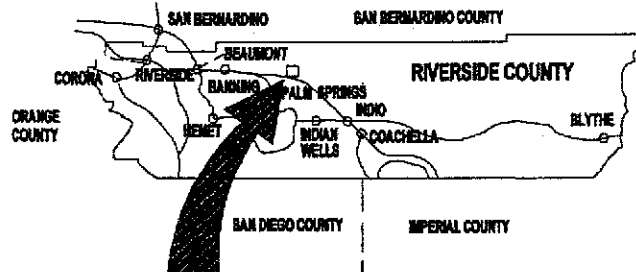
The contractor is qualified.

AGREEMENT

COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

PROJECT NO. B7-0768

HSIPL – 5956 (174)

THIS AGREEMENT, made and concluded in duplicate as of the date set forth below, between the County of Riverside, party of the first part, and **Trinity Construction**, Contractor, party of the second part.

ARTICLE I: WITNESSETH, that for and in consideration of the payments and agreements hereinafter mentioned, to be made and performed by the said party of the first part, and under the conditions expressed in the two bonds, bearing even date with these presents, the said party of the second part agrees with the said party of the first part, at his own proper cost and expense, to do all the work and furnish all the materials, except such as are mentioned in the specifications to be furnished by said party of the first part, necessary to construct and complete in a good, workmanlike and substantial manner and to the satisfaction of the County of Riverside, in accordance with the Special Provisions, "Notice to Contractors", the State of California Department of Industrial Relations Wage Determination, the Federal Wage Determination, the Proposal to the County of Riverside for the Project, **addenda No.1**, the Bid Bond, the Performance Bond, the Payment Bond, any specific plans for the project not covered by the Standard Specifications and Standard Plans, any change orders issued, and any written instructions and drawings executed and delivered to the Contractor by the County pursuant to the Contract Documents. Also in accordance with the Standard Plans, dated May 2006, the Standard Specifications, dated May 2006, the General Prevailing Wage Rates of the Department of Transportation, with the effective date being the date of advertisement, and the Labor Surcharge and Equipment Rental Rates, with the effective date being the date of advertisement, and the Labor Surcharge and Equipment Rental Rates, with the effective date being the date of accomplishing the work, which said special provisions Standard Plans, Standard Specifications, Prevailing Wage Rates, and Labor Surcharge and Equipment Rental Rates are hereby specially referred to and by such reference, made a part hereof.

The work to be done is shown on plans entitled **Mountain View Road, Installation of Metal Beam Guard Railing and AC Dike; Project No. B7-0768, HSIPL-5956 (174), Sheets 1 and 2, approved December 5, 2008**, on file with the County Surveyor, which said project plans are hereby made a part of this contract.

ARTICLE II: The said party of the first part hereby promises and agrees with the said Contractor to employ, and does hereby employ, the said Contractor to provide the materials and to do the work according to the terms and conditions herein contained and referred to, for the prices hereinafter set forth, and hereby contracts to pay the same at the time, in the manner and upon the conditions herein set forth; and the said parties for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, do hereby agree to the full performance of the covenants herein contained.

ARTICLE III: The statement of prevailing wages appearing in the General Prevailing Wage Rates is hereby specifically referred to and by this reference is made a part of this contract. It is further expressly agreed by and between the parties hereto that should there be any conflict between the terms of this instrument and the bid or proposal of said Contractor, then this instrument shall control and nothing herein shall be considered as an acceptance of the said terms of said proposal conflicting herewith.

ARTICLE IV: By my signature hereunder, as Contractor, I certify that I am aware of the provisions of Section 3700 of the Labor Code which require every employer to be insured against liability for workmen's compensation or to undertake self-insurance in accordance with the provisions of that code and I will comply with such provisions before commencing the performance of the work of this contract.

ARTICLE V: And the said Contractor agrees to receive and accept the following prices as full compensation for furnishing all materials and for doing all the work contemplated and embraced in this agreement; also for all loss or damage, arising out of the nature of the work aforesaid, or from the action of the elements, or from any unforeseen difficulties or obstructions which may arise or be encountered in the prosecution of the work until its acceptance by the County of Riverside, and for all risks of every description connected with the work; also for all expenses incurred by or in consequence of the suspension or discontinuance of work and for well and faithfully completing the work, and the whole thereof, in the manner and according to the plans and specifications, and the requirements of the Engineer under them, to wit:
