SUBJECT: Approval of the Office on Aging's 2009-2012 Strategic Plan "Bridging the Generations for the Future..."

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve and authorize Chairman of the Board to execute the attached Transmittal Letter for the 2009-2012 Strategic Plan, *Bridging the Generations for the Future...*
2. Direct the Clerk of the Board to return the Transmittal Letter to the Office on Aging for further processing.

BACKGROUND:

Normally, the Office on Aging, in coordination with the Advisory Council on Aging and the community, is mandated by the Older Americans Act and the Older Californians Act to develop a four year area plan that is updated annually. However, a decision was made by the California Department of Aging to decrease this plan cycle to three years (as a one time only change). Therefore, this is the first year of the 2009-2012 Strategic Plan, "Bridging the Generations for the Future..." The Plan was developed based on 2007-2009 needs assessment activities with broad based community input. Four priority goals were identified as follows: Goal I: Improve Service Delivery Systems and Strengthen Infrastructure; Goal II: Coordination and Community Integration; Goal III: Life Care Planning; and Goal IV: Improve Health and Quality of Life. A key piece of this plan is the inclusion of activities related to the Aging and Disability Resource Connection. This (continued on page 2)
