**RE:** **Request for Extension of Report to Board of Supervisors regarding Density Transfer and Density Bonus Programs (item 3.26 from 4/15/08 agenda) for one week from April 28, 2009 to May 5, 2009.**

The Planning Department requests that a report back to the Board of Supervisors on the implementation of the Density Transfer and Density Bonus programs (from Item 3.26 of 4/15/08) be extended for one week, from April 28 to May 5, 2009.

The reason for this request is that a key public member in the development of these programs, Dr. Dan Silver, cannot be present at the Board meeting on April 28, 2009, but is able to attend the Board's May 5, 2009 meeting. Dr. Silver wishes to address the Board regarding these programs. As you may know, Dr. Silver represents the Endangered Habitats League, which sued the County in regard to its adoption of our General Plan in 2003; in part due to our not having programs like these in place at that time. He is also a member of the Ad-hoc Advisory Committee to the Planning Director, whose purpose is to advise the County on the development of these programs. Dr. Silver has expressed satisfaction with the recent progress of these programs. Therefore, it would be beneficial to all to accommodate this one week extension request.
