SUBJECT: License Agreement for Bain Street's trail improvements adjacent to the San Sevaine Channel (450' North of Limonite Avenue to Galena Street), Mira Loma area.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve the License Agreement between the Riverside County Transportation Department (County), the Riverside County Flood Control District (District) and the Riverside County Regional Park and Open Space District (Parks) and authorize the chairman to execute same.

BACKGROUND: The agreement sets forth the terms and conditions by which the County will design and construct the proposed regional trail improvements along Bain Street within the District and the County's right of way. Parks will provide funding and will be responsible to operate and maintain the trail after construction completion.

RE: Cooperative Agreement between the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District), the County of Riverside (County) and Riverside County Regional Parks and Open Space District (Parks)

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The limits of the proposed trail improvements are from 450 ft. north of Limonite Avenue to Galena Street. The trail will be located 35 ft. from the Bain Street's edge of pavement and approximately 6' from the San Sevaine Channel's existing fence. The improvements will consist of a 2-Mile long and 10 ft. wide decomposed granite pathway with a wood post fence and 2 ft. buffer on each side of the trail. The San Sevaine Channel will not be used for this trail.

By minute order 3.31 of March 3, 2009, the County entered into an agreement with Parks for terms and conditions by which the County will be reimbursed for performing design and construction services for the project.

By minute order 3.41 of April 7, 2009, the Board approved the plans and specifications for the construction of Regional Trail on Bain Street, and authorized the Clerk to advertise for bids.

This agreement is also on the Parks and District's agenda on this same date and has been approved as to legal form by County Counsel.
