SUBJECT: Resolution No. 2009-141 Reducing Permissible Vehicle Weight on County Highways in the Glen Avon Area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors adopt Resolution 2009-141, Reducing the Permissible Weight of Vehicles on:

- 1) Conning Street between Mission Blvd and Bain Street;
- 2) Bain Street between San Sevaine Way and Union Street;
- 3) Union Street between Bain Street and Bellegrave Avenue; and
- 4) Lindsay Street between Bellegrave Avenue and Mission Boulevard.

BACKGROUND: In accordance with Ordinance 500.1, the Board of Supervisors has the authority to reduce permissible weight of commercial vehicles on certain County highways that



are within residential areas, if the use is determined to adversely affect traffic or safety. (Ordinance No. 500.1 provides exemptions such as public transit buses, emergency response vehicles, etc.) The reduction shall not be effective until signs are posted to give public notice of the weight restriction.

Community concerns have been raised regarding trucks using Conning Street, Lindsay Street, Bain and Union Streets between San Sevaine Way and Bellegrave Avenue. Truck traffic has been observed using these roads as a cut-through from the industrial uses on Bellegrave and to access Van Buren Boulevard from State Route 60 and Mission Boulevard.

An engineering study was completed to review the circulation for commercial vehicles in the areas. Based on the field review, it has been determined that the subject two-lane residential streets are not suitable for use by commercial vehicles in excess of 14,000 pounds (7-tons).

To reduce the impact of commercial vehicle traffic on the existing residential neighborhoods, it is recommended that Conning Street between Mission Boulevard and Bain Street, Bain Street between San Sevaine Way and Union Street, Union Street between Bain Street and Bellegrave Avenue, and Lindsay Street between Bellegrave Avenue and Mission Boulevard, be restricted to vehicles less than seven (7) tons. (See Attached Map).

The alternate routes for trucks are designated as:

- 1) Mission Boulevard;
- 2) Bellegrave Avenue; and
- 3) San Sevaine Way.

The Riverside Area Office of the CHP was contacted regarding the proposed vehicle weight reduction.

6 BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors, County of
7 Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on _____, 2009, that pursuant to
8 Ordinance 500.1, Section 5, a maximum 7-ton weight restriction is hereby established on the following
9 County highways:

- 10 1. Conning Street, between Mission Boulevard and Bain Street, a total distance of
11 approximately 0.24 mile;
- 12 2. Bain Street, between San Sevaine Way and Union Street, a total distance of approximately
13 0.24 mile;
- 14 3. Union Street, between Bain Street and Bellegrave Avenue, a total distance of
15 approximately 0.56 mile; and
- 16 4. Lindsay Street, between Bellegrave Avenue and Mission Boulevard, a total distance of
17 approximately 0.26 mile.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED, that pursuant to Ordinance
19 No. 500.1, Section 8, the Transportation Department is hereby directed to post appropriate signs to give
20 notice of the weight restriction prior to enforcement of the restrictions set forth herein.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED, that pursuant to Ordinance
22 No. 500.1, Section 9, the alternate routes designated for commercial vehicles over 7-tons to use are:

- 23 (1) Mission Boulevard;
- 24 (2) Bellegrave Avenue; and
- 25 (3) San Sevaine Way.
