City of Wildomar will incur the traffic signal operation and maintenance costs after the signal is constructed.

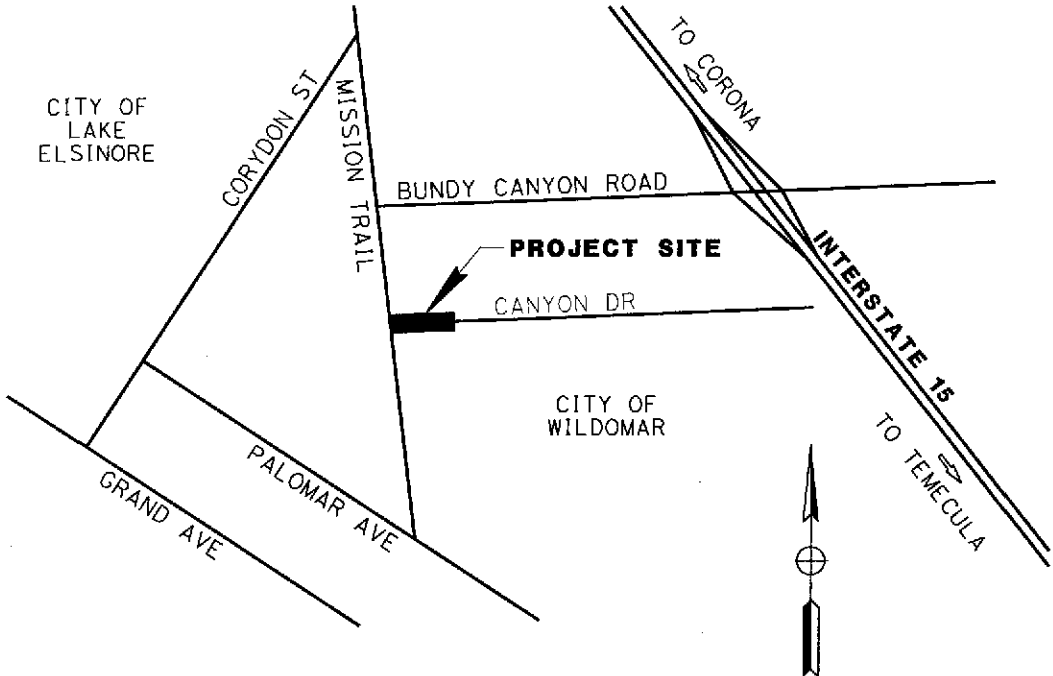
The Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659.6, allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities. The Safe Route to School funds are state funds for which the Department successfully competed.

The relocation of the fire hydrant, owned by Elsinore Valley Municipal Water District, is included in the bid package as an alternate bid schedule. If the District approves the award of the alternate bid schedule as bid by the apparent low bidder, the costs for the work will be funded by the District.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.
